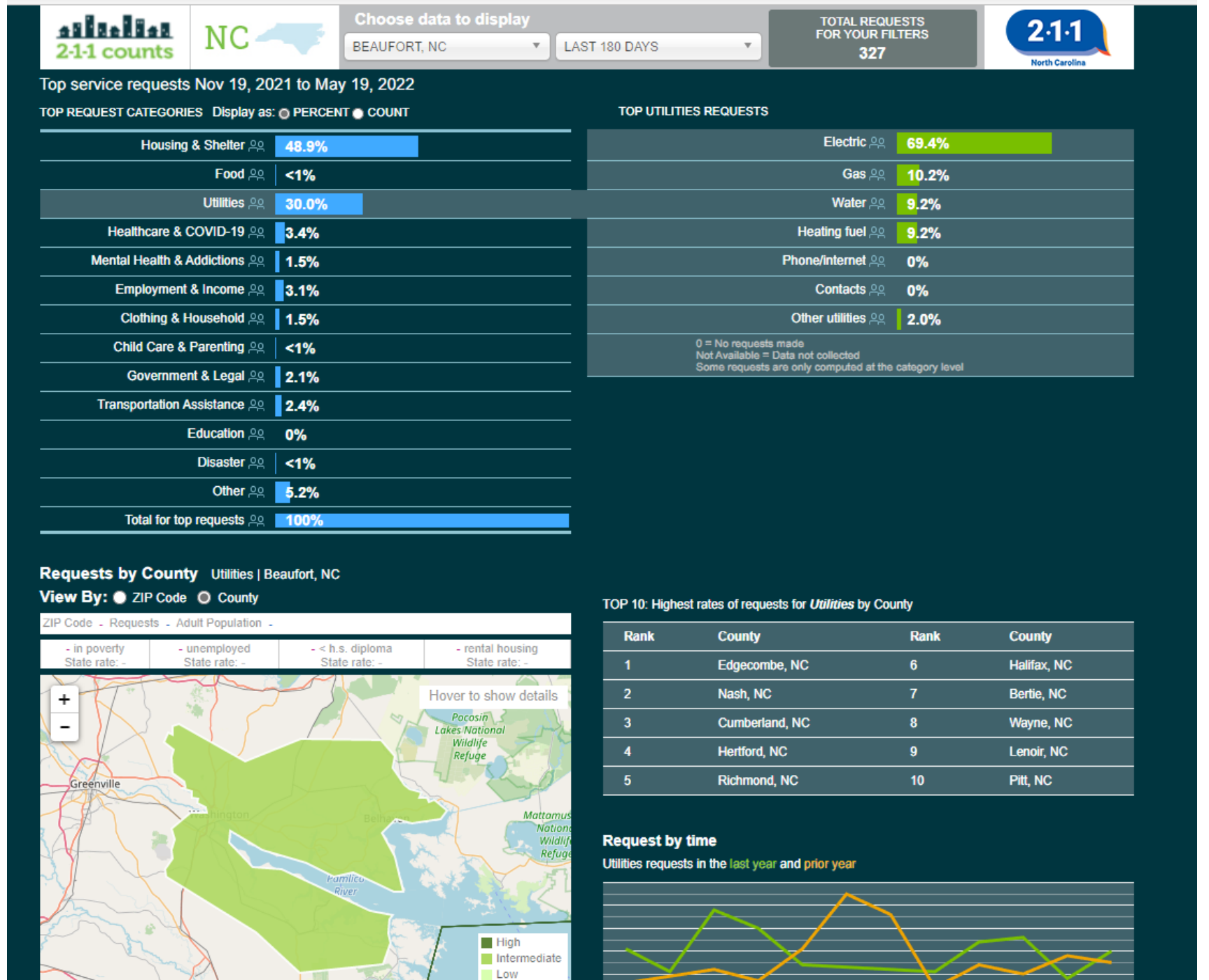

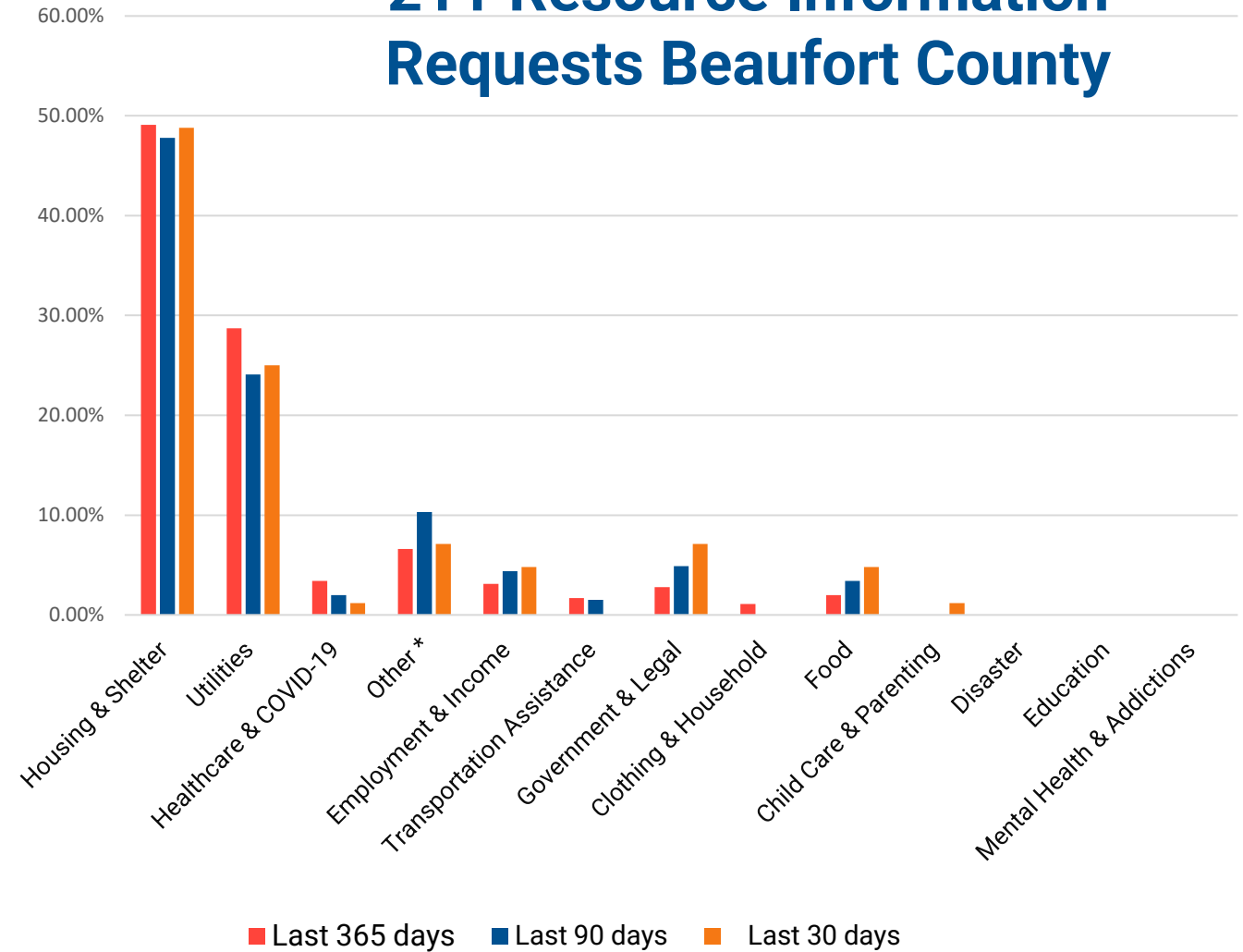

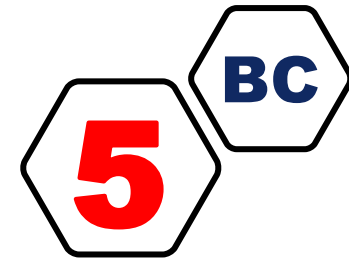

## Support Nonprofit Capacity Building

- How to host a Neighborhood SOCKTOBER**
- Organize a drop-off location on a neighbor's or another central location in the neighborhood.
  - Dress up a box or tote.
  - If it will be left outside, make sure to use a weather-resistant container.
  - Decorate it so it stands out! Include a sign for the neighborhood.
  - Issue a challenge to other neighborhoods, or other.
  - At the end of the collection period, be sure to collect and thank all who donated.



- Organize a drop-off location at work.
- Dress up a box or collection device.
- Decorate it so it stands out! Include a sign. Then get the word out to your co-workers. Invite contractors and vendors to participate.
- Set a goal of how many to collect.
- Organize an interdepartmental challenge to see who can collect the most pairs of socks!
- If you work with the public, or customers, place the collection bin where they can also contribute to the challenge.
- At the end of the collection period, make sure to publicize how many socks were collected and thank all who participated.
